Talking Mats® is a visual framework which uses picture symbols to help people with communication difficulties. It has the potential for use with a wide range of people and is an approach which helps them think about issues and provides them with a way of expressing their views more easily.

Poor communication can cause difficulties and consequently choices and life options can be limited. This is true for a wide range of people no matter what their cause of their communication difficulty. Talking Mats is one tool that can help overcome this.

Talking Mats® training is coming to London, with a full day's training course at the Royal College of Speech and Language Therapists (RCSLT) on Monday 8 December 2008. The course cost includes lunch.

The course will be held at the RCSLT, 2 White Hart Yard, London, SE1 1NX Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
